We are looking at possibly moving the storage unit and looking at what we are paying for the web site. Ron is going to dig into the web site contact once he has access. Need to look into the free storage space Brett is offering. We are worried it isn't climate controlled and could cause water damage to our tents. Vadra will look into it though.
